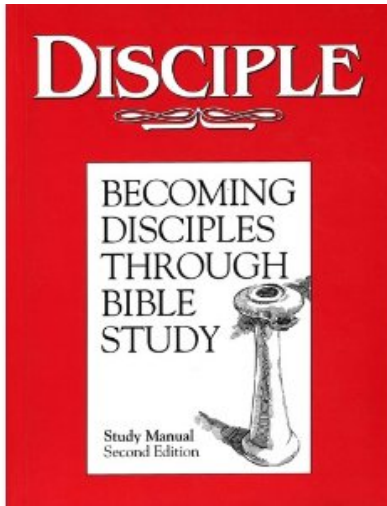

Disciple 1: Becoming Disciples through Bible Study

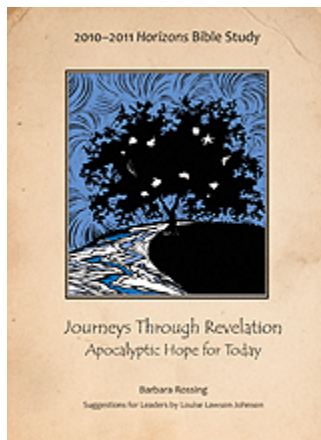

Morning Circle: "Journeys through Revelation: Apocalyptic Hope for Today."

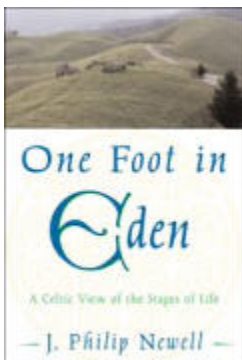
