The Youth Class (for ages 4 through grade 5) meets after the Time for Children in worship. The curriculum is based on the following big truths:

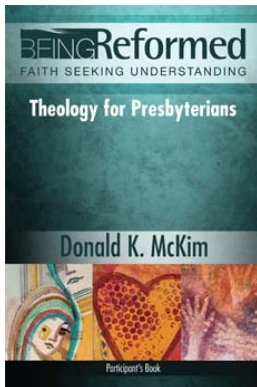
- God is a great big God
